**DAY 01-WEDNESDAY GLASGOW or LONDON to SINGAPORE (VIA DUBAI)**

**30 MAY 2012**

Afternoon fly from Glasgow/London airport to Singapore via Dubai on Emirates Airlines

**DAY 02-THURSDAY DUBAI/SINGAPORE**

**31 MAY 2012**

Arrive Dubai and change to your connecting flight to Singapore

Afternoon arrive Singapore, meeting, assistance on arrival and transferred to your hotel. Free at leisure.

Overnight stay *Swissotel Merchant Court or similar for 3 nights (4 Star)*

**DAY 03-FRIDAY**

Morning proceed for city tour of Singapore with a drive around the Civic District past the Padang, Cricket Club, Parliament House, Supreme Court and City Hall. You'll have great views of Marina Bay when you stop for photos at Merlion Park and the Merlion itself, Singapore's mythological creature that is part lion, part fish. Later enjoy a 30 minutes boat ride along the Singapore River.

Then, continue your journey northwards to the Kranji War Memorial. Unveiled in 1957, the memorial commemorates over 20,000 men and women who gave their lives for freedom in World War II. Lunch at a local restaurant and then continue visit Changi Chapel & Museum. The museum focuses on the memories and lives of both POWs and civilian internees who survived the Japanese Occupation while the Changi Chapel is a replica of the original chapel found in the Changi Prison. Visit to Selarang Garrison (visit subject to approval) before returning to hotel and free at leisure.

Overnight stay *Singapore.*

This historic city of Malacca is a living museum, with both ruins and intact buildings from bygone era is right in the heart of the town.

The Stadthuys - known as the Red Square, is a historical structure situated in the heart of Malacca Town. It was built by the Dutch occupants in 1650 as the office of the Dutch Governor and Deputy Governor. After the visit continue journey to Kuala Lumpur, the capital of Malaysia. Arrive Kuala Lumpur check-in to hotel and free at leisure.

**IPOH/SUNGAI SIPUT/KUALA KANGSAR/KAMUNTING/PENANG  
Meals Included: Breakfast**

Morning depart for Penang and enroute visit Sungai Siput, Kamunting Christian cemetery and Kuala Kangsar

During the Malayan Emergency between 1948 and 1960, Kamunting was the site of a major British/Commonwealth military base, there being a large garrison for the 28th Commonwealth Independent Infantry Brigade and also one of the three British Military Hospitals (BMHs) in Malaya. Between Taiping and Kamunting is one of the main Military Cemeteries in Malaya. Over the many years of the conflict against the Communist terrorists, thousands of British, Australian, New Zealand, Fijian and Gurkha troops lived and died in and around Kamunting and Taiping

After visit proceed to Penang via Penang Bridge. Upon arrival, check-in to hotel and free at leisure.

Overnight stay at ***Holiday Inn or similar for 5 nights (3-4 Star)***

**DAY 14-TUESDAY  
12 JUNE 2012**

Today you explore Penang - the Pearl of the Orient and the oldest British settlement in Malaysia. George Town, the capital city of Penang was named after King George III of England, is an interesting land of the old & new. It is worth to note that Penang has one of the largest Colonial Buildings in South East Asia. This tour includes a stop at Fort Cornwallis, built in 1808. Fort Cornwallis also marks the spot where Sir Francis Light first landed on this island. You will be driven through Street Harmony, which houses the Anglican Church, Kuan Yin Chinese Temple, Mahamariam Indian Temple and the Kapitan Keling Mosque. Followed by visit to the State Museum built in 1821, which houses a fine collection of old photographs, maps, charts and pass by the colourful Little India and bustling Chinatown. The next stop will be to the reclining Buddha Statue which is the World's 4th largest at Wat Chayamangkalaram. Enroute will also visit Khoo Kongsi a chinese Clan established in 1835

Continue visit to the Western Road Cemetery which is the biggest Christian cemetery in Penang. Also buried at the Western Road Cemetery are British soldiers who died fighting communists during the Emergency Campaign of 1948-1960. A memorial is erected to them near the gate into the cemetery. There are also graves to soldiers from the Royal Australian Air Force, RAAF. After tour return to hotel and free at leisure!
